**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow remedial works to Wye level crossing to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bridge Street, Wye.

The closures are planned as follows;

**from 22:00 hours on 5th November 2022,
with estimated completion by 06:00 hours on 7th November 2022,**

with estimated completion by 06:00 hours on 19th December 2022,**

or where stated on a valid Permit (KL835ACR-06-28-051122 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd).

**Bridge Street will be closed between Harville Road and Station House, to the extent indicated
by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while remedial works to
Wye level crossing are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Harville Road, A28 Canterbury Road, A2070
Willesborough Road/Kennington Road, The Street, Hinxhill Road, Hinxhill Road From
Junction With Goodcheap Lane To Nackolt Road, Nacolts Road, Oxenturn Road and Bridge
Street.**

**In reverse - via Bridge Street, Churchfield Way, Church Street, Oxenturn Road, Nacolts Road,
Hinxhill Road From Junction With Goodcheap Lane To Nackolt Road, Hinxhill Road, The
Street, A2070 Kennington Road/Willesborough Road, A28 Canterbury Road and Harville
Road.**
